

Cheer Coach

The Cheer Coach's primary responsibility is to promote school spirit through energy, excitement, and enthusiasm for the Cheer and Estancia Bear programs. As such, the Cheer Coach will assist cheerleaders in promoting school spirit, school pride, and encouraging the members of the athletic teams. Their involvement and enthusiasm in the school and at events helps students, families, and community members feel Bear Pride. The Cheer Coach will promote positive teamwork, expect positive interactions amongst teammates, and encourage sportsmanship and fan involvement at games and pep assemblies. The Cheer Coach will be knowledgeable of and able to safely teach cheerleading techniques, including tumbling, stunts, jumps, and dance while developing and maintaining a positive and inclusive team environment, promoting team spirit and unity. The successful candidate will have experience as a cheerleader or cheerleading coach, possess strong knowledge of cheerleading techniques and routines, have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, demonstrate the ability to motivate and inspire athletes to achieve their goals, have organizational and management skills, and have familiarity with safety guidelines and regulations for cheerleading activities. Candidates must have or be willing to immediately obtain NMAA and PED coach licensure, including meeting all training, first aid certification, and other requirements. Qualified candidates must submit a letter of interest outlining their vision and goals for the Estancia Cheer program as well as complete the classified application and submit both items to personnel@emsdbears.us by November 1st. Interviews will be conducted thereafter in preparation for spring coaching.
